

How to Play Superstruct

- 1) Register for the game at <http://superstructgame.org/UserRegistration>
Complete your personal Survival Profile, and invent your future self.
- 2) Read “How to Play” on the game website

- 3) Start contributing to the museum superstructs! (Superstructs are working groups that bring together diverse people to work together to solve a problem.)
 - a) Go to the game home page (www.superstructgame.org) and click on “Superstructure” at the bottom of the page. Use the search function at the bottom left corner of the superstruct form page to find the CFM superstructs by searching on “Center for the Future of Museums”.
 - b) When you find a superstruct you want to work on, click join. See the “discuss this superstruct” section to access the link to the associated wiki document. (Copy and paste the wiki URL into your browser.)
 - c) Enter your thoughts in the wiki—how can we address this issue? What other questions should we be asking ourselves? At the end of the six week run of the game, these wikis will be turned into the full text of the “Museums and Society: 2019” report.
- 4) Get creative! Explore the game site, read the news, start recording your own stories from 2019. What is happening in your life, at your museum, in your community? Use photos, videos, blogs, podcasts and wikis to help create a vivid picture of the future.
- 5) Look for, read and “rave” interesting museum content! This will help bring museum issues to the forefront of the game.
